**Policies & Procedures**

- Proper Golf Attire is required.
- Collared shirts for men, slacks or shorts, golf or tennis shoes.
- No jogging shorts or cut offs. Blue jeans must be in good condition. Ladies may wear sleeveless or proper tee shirts.
- Do not enter private properties to retrieve balls.
- All players must have their own set of clubs.
- Starting on any hole other than the #1 requires permission from the golf shop.
- Any damage or injury caused by the golfer is the sole responsibility of the golfer. This includes residential areas.
- Private coolers are not allowed.
- 90° cart rule.

**Golf Course Rules**

- U.S.G.A. rules govern all play.
- All fairway yardage markers are measured to the center of the green.
- Out of bounds is defined by fenced property line or white stakes.
- Nearest relief + club length from swing and stance regarding cart paths and flagged or staked trees.
- All water hazards are to be played as penalty areas under Rule 17 unless otherwise designated.
- #4 and #5 water hazard – Re-hit or use drop circle.
- Walls defining out of bounds are fixed; no relief.
- Within 4 ft of the homeowners' walls and perimeter of the property where grass is not maintained is considered Ground Under Repair.
- All desert landscaping is considered ground under repair.
- It is the ranger's responsibility to keep play moving at a reasonable speed.
- ARS 4-244.39 – It is unlawful for a customer to bring liquor onto the licensee's premises.
